- *Laptops for Loan*: The Canyons Board of Education approved a plan to aid students who have no access to computing devices or the Internet at home. Through a grant, the District intends to make computers available to these students, starting with high school students, in much the same way that libraries check-out books, except for a more extended period of time. The grant also will cover half the cost of making hotspots available to the students so that they have Internet access at home. The remainder of the costs may also be partially covered through Utah’s Digital Teaching and Learning grant.
