



Peruvian Park Elementary
School Land Trust
Final Report Summary 2013-14

Peruvian Park Elementary School Community Council determined that School Land Trust funding for 2013-14 be used to increase the reading achievement of students identified as reading below benchmark as measured on Reading CBM testing. Students received daily intervention support from intervention assistants under the direction of the achievement coach. Most of the allocated School Land Trust funding, \$23,747, was used to hire three assistants to provide reading interventions. Materials were purchased for teachers and assistants to use during intervention time, \$1,879. Students who received Tier 2 intervention support showed an average increased growth rate of 14 % - 48% above class averages in all grade levels, except for first grade. The Council determined that a carry-over amount of \$7253 should be reserved for the 2014-15 school year to provide math and technology support for students.
