Approval of October minutes – moved by Ms. Jewkes and seconded by Mrs. Murray. Approved unanimously

Budget review – current balance \$33,453, technology expenditure is \$1516 for iPads for the fifth grade teachers. They are using these with Doceri to allow them to instruct from anywhere in the room and have students participate more fully in the learning. Approximately \$7200 has gone to intervention assistants in classrooms.

Data – progress monitoring not available at this time. The assessments have not yet been received from the district copy center.

Digital Citizenship – The council discussed the district filters that are used in the schools. There is a variation in the restrictions based on grade level with elementary filters being the most restrictive. The council discussed classroom use and school policy on misuse. Students are taught specific expectations when using the internet and the process to use if something inappropriate pops up on a screen. Teachers monitor technology use carefully and handle minor infractions. Major infractions for technology misuse are referred to Ms. Jewkes. Ms. Jewkes informed the council of the new technology purchases and how different grade levels are using the technology.

Mrs. Kratz will check on district technology resource person preparing a presentation for parents, possibly at Parent Teacher Conferences. Ms. Jewkes reminded members that Mrs. Chang, our school digital citizenship coordinator, has a tech corner on the website. Ms. Jewkes will include a reminder in her weekly email to parents.

The council reviewed Emergency Safety Procedures at the school. These drills will be practiced Dec-February. Ms. Jewkes will send parents more detailed information about the drills shortly before they are conducted.
