

Peruvian Park Elementary School Community Council spent \$65,136 of LAND Trust funds to provide essential support to our students for the 2019 - 20 school year.

Peruvian Park Elementary School Community Council was pleased to be able to spend \$65,136 of LAND Trust funds in our school for the 2019 - 20 school year. It was determined that funds should be spent on reading, math, and technology. To increase reading and math achievement, students were identified as performing below benchmark on Acadience testing. Students identified received daily intervention support from intervention assistants under the direction of the achievement coach. Most of the allocated School Land Trust funding, \$35,056, was used to hire three assistants to provide reading interventions and two assistants to provide math interventions. A total of \$2,497 was spent on substitutes. They were utilized so teachers could participate in coaching cycles and collaboration to improve their capacity in curriculum, whole group and skill-based instruction. Supplies were purchased to support reading and math instruction, \$2,804. K - 1st grade teachers prefer using iPads with their Panthers. iPads and Chromebooks were purchased for literacy and math support for \$24,779. Peruvian Park is striving to be 1:1 with iPads and Chromebooks across the school. The Peruvian Park SCC sees our LAND Trust Plan resources as a crucial component of our student achievement.

Peruvian Park Teacher Student Success Plan Goals 2019-20

Language Arts

At least 80% of neighborhood students will achieve benchmark or advance one level towards benchmark on spring 2020 Acadience reading assessments and/or Reading Inventory (RI proficient level).

Math

At least 80% of neighborhood students in K - 5th will reach/exceed benchmark or advance at least one level towards benchmark on the Acadience Mathematics Composite assessments in spring 2020.

Due to the soft closure in March, end of the year data is not available. Winter benchmark data was used to indicate progress toward goals.

- 68% of neighborhood students were at benchmark level in the fall as measured by the Acadience reading assessment. 76% of neighborhood students were at benchmark on the winter assessment 42% of 4th 5th neighborhood students were at proficient level in the fall on Reading Inventory assessments. 55% of neighborhood students were at proficient level on the winter assessment.
- 68% of neighborhood students were at benchmark level in the fall on the Acadience math assessment. 76% of neighborhood students were at benchmark on the winter assessment.
